MACC 24-25 FALL SEMESTER DUAL CREDIT ONLINE (DCON) INFORMATION

- 1. Students taking a MACC Dual Credit Online (DCON) course must complete the online application with MACC.
 - a. If you completed your application last year or this most recent semester it is still good, you do not have to fill out another one.
 - b. If you are new to DCON you will need to visit the link below and complete the online Dual Credit Application by **Friday, May 3, 2024**.
 - i. https://my.macc.edu/ICS/Admissions/ (click on the Dual Credit Application Button)
- 2. In order to take any MACC DCON class you must have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- 3. DCON classes start on Tuesday, August 27, 2024 and will end on Friday, December 6, 2024.
 - a. You should use your class time prior to the 30th as a study hall period.
- 4. MACC will be visiting us on **TBD** to collect payment.
 - a. You will be required to have payment in full or set up a payment plan with MACC. If you set up a payment plan you will be required to bring the first payment on the <u>TBD</u>.
- 5. Cost of Dual Credit classes are 80.00 per credit hour. This price may change slightly each year. If it does change we will let you know. You will need to multiply your class hours by 80.00 (i.g. 3 hours x 80.00 = 240.00) in order to determine the cost of the class. Be sure to add the cost of any books required for the class so you have an accurate total. Some classes are more than 3 hours of college credit. They are:
 - a. BIO101: 4 credit hours (320.00 plus book)
 - b. BIO205: 4 credit hours (320.00 plus book)
 - c. PHY101: 4 credit hours (320.00 plus book)
- 6. The MACC DCON Book list is included in this packet (or will be made available when received).
- 7. In order to take MTH140 (College Algebra) you will need:
 - a. A minimum Math ACT score of 22 with a 3.0 GPA or higher, OR
 - b. Accuplacer Next-Gen AAF Test score of 230 or higher with a 3.0 GPA
 - i. Students will receive one free test attempt at HHS.
 - ii. All qualifying attempts must be made prior to May 24, 2024.
 - c. If you do not qualify for the course you will be required to choose another DCON course or be placed in a class available that hour.
- 8. In order to take LAL101 or 102 (Composition I or II) you will need:
 - a. A minimum Math English and Reading score of 18 with a 3.0 GPA or higher, OR
 - b. Accuplacer Next-Gen Reading and Writing Test score of 250 or higher with a 3.0 GPA
 - i. Students will receive one free test attempt at HHS.
 - ii. All qualifying attempts must be made prior to May 24, 2024.
 - c. If you do not qualify for the course you will be required to choose another DCON course or be placed in a class available that hour.
 - d. You must have successfully completed LAL101 before you can take LAL102
- 9. Students should request DCON classes by filling out the attached form and returning it to Mr. Boyer no later than Friday, April 26, 2024.
